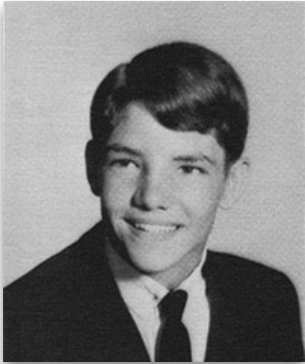




A Remembrance of John H. (“Jay”) Brickley

At Coronado High School, Jay was Senior Class Vice-President; he played both varsity basketball and baseball; and was a member of the Choir, the Vaqueros, and the Lettermen’s Club.
