



A Remembrance of Carol Lynn Theresa Franklin

1949 – 1972



At Coronado High School, Carol sang in the Choir; was a Cheerleader; participated in Hi-Jinks; was a member of the Ensemble, the Booster Club, the Pep Committee, and the senior Homecoming Court; and was voted Senior Standout—Most School Spirit.

After graduation, Carol married her high school sweetheart—Doug Scaramozzino—Coronado High School Class of 1966. Soon after, they moved to the Seattle, Washington area where Doug began his service in the U.S. Navy.

On April 2, 1972, near Wenatchee, Washington, Carol was a passenger in a car driven by Doug when their vehicle was hit head-on by a wrong-way driver. Carol was seriously injured, later succumbing to her injuries, while her husband Doug spent time in Wenatchee Hospital but recovered.

At the time of her death, Carol was survived by her husband Doug Scaramozzino; her parents Mr. and Mrs. John H. Franklin; a sister Joyce ; and a brother John, all of Coronado, California.
