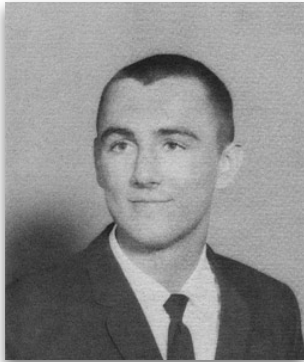




## **A Remembrance of John Douglas Scanlon**

***1949 – 1977***



Services were August 31, 1977 for John Douglas Scanlon, 27, a U.S. Forest Service technician who died August 27 in an fire truck accident. An Ohio native, Scanlon lived in Coronado for a number of years, graduating from Coronado High School in 1967 before moving to San Diego. He was killed when his fire truck overturned on the Anderson Truck Trail near El Capitan Reservoir. He was a graduate of University of California at San Diego and had been a U.S. Forest Service employee for five years. John is survived by his wife, Joan; his parents Mr. and Mrs. John A. Scanlon of Cuba; two brothers, James and Joseph, both of Coronado; and a sister, Judy Scanlon of San Diego.
