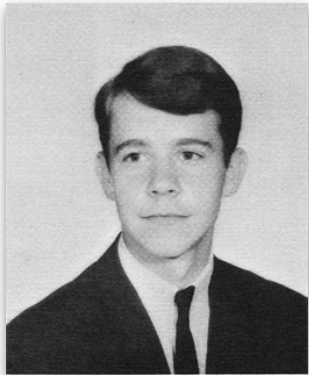




## A Remembrance of Dennis Bruce Fink
